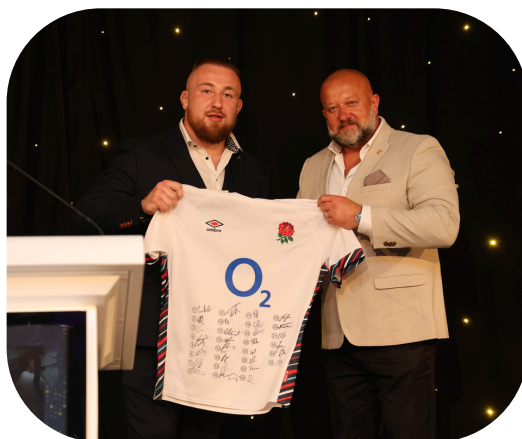

As an Education Tutor, you will be responsible for the delivery of high-quality, safe and inclusive education through our Alternative Provision, working with young people of school age and post-16 on a one-to-one or small group basis.

The young people we work with have often struggled in mainstream education for a variety of reasons. Some may have been excluded, others may have SEMH or SEN needs, and many require a flexible, personalised approach to learning to help them re-engage and achieve a basic education.

You will have strong, proven tutoring skills, with experience teaching in schools or other educational settings. You will bring the drive, enthusiasm and resilience needed to work with some of the hardest-to-reach young people, and the creativity to make learning engaging and accessible.
